“ARE INFANTS BORN PURE?”

TEXTS: Isaiah 59:1,2; Ezekiel 18: 14-21; 1 John 3:4; Rom. 4:15

INTRODUCTION:

Let's begin this lesson reading from a book called *The Way of Salvation In The Lutheran Church*, page 27. “The Lutheran Church, then teaches and confesses nothing but the pure truth of God’s word when in the Augsburg Confession, Article II”

She says: “Also they, that after Adam’s fall, all men, begotten after the common course of nature, are born with sin!”

“How long will it be before that helpless and seemingly innocent babe, that slumbers on its mother’s breast, shows symptoms of anger, jealousy, stubbornness and disobedience? Let that child alone, and without a teacher, it will learn to lie, deceive, steal, curse and give pain to others.”

The Book of Discipline of the United Methodist Church, page 68, Article VII:

“Original sin standeth not in the following of Adam, but it is the corruption of the nature of every man, that naturally is engendered of the offspring of Adam, whereby man is very far gone from the original righteousness, and of his own nature inclined to evil, and that continually.”

Wesley’s Works, Miscellaneous, Volume 2, page 16:

“Infants need to be washed from original sin; therefore they are proper subjects of baptism.”
